The Embassy of India presents its compliments to the University of Oradea and has the honor to inform that the Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR), Government of India, is offering two Scholarships, one is the Cultural Exchange Programme / Education Exchange Programme (A1206) and the other is a Scholarship Scheme for Indian Culture (A1209) for pursuing study of Indian Culture such as dance, music, theatre, performing art, sculpture, Indian languages, Indian cuisine, etc., for the academic year 2021-22 for students from Romania. Scholarships are offered for pursuing undergraduate/postgraduate courses in different subjects, but excluding Medical/Paramedical (Nursing/Physiotherapy/Anesthesia), etc. and fashion courses. Entire cost of tuition fees and boarding/lodging is paid for by ICCR.

Interested candidates from Romania, with good knowledge of English, may apply for the scholarships. The candidates may visit the ICCR's A2A (Admissions to Alumni) Scholarship Portal at www.a2ascholarships. iccr.gov.in for registration, eligibility and admission criteria laid down by various Institutes / Universities and other detailed information on various fields of study/research offered by the higher educational institutions in India in order to ensure they meet the eligibility criteria. The applicants should be in the age group of 18-30 years i.e. should be not less than 18 years and not more than 30 years of age for undergraduate/postgraduate courses.

Before applying online on the ICCR Portal at www.a2ascholarships.iccr.gov.in, the prospective candidates may please be advised to carefully go through all the headings in the website. A sample application form, a physical fitness form, ICCR guidelines for filling forms are attached. All candidates need to fill the form online.
